Project Guidelines

The facilitators have been working with stakeholders to find a way to garner broad support for projects, but still be sensitive that some charter signees are not comfortable with materials implying support for a project, with which they have fundamental concerns. Projects that garner broad support should proceed quickly, thus increasing our pace and scale.

SOFAR Consensus Project

Collaborative project which all charter signatories support.

SOFAR Cohesive Strategy

Works toward three goals in the SOFAR watershed.

Project

Project that supports 1 or more of the 3 goals. Project partners sign-on as needed or interested. [Concept is that more projects are underway than the collaborative can discuss.]

Notes on Level of Engagement

If project is within the Collaborative's zones of agreements, i.e. it is a project that makes a lot of sense to move forward, the Collaborative may provide a low-level of input.

If project is more complex or subject to potential concerns, the Collaborative or its working committee(s) may commit the time and resources to develop the project so the Collaborative can support the project.

Collaboration Priority Focus Areas

Areas identified and worked on to develop strategy collaboratively for all lands work toward 3 goals.

Project in the SOFAR Watershed

Partners advancing projects independently of SOFAR collaborative that do not meet any of the goals. [i.e. trail project or road decommissioning]
